### About last chapter meeting

The last chapter meeting was held at Teikoku Oil Company Technical Research Center conference room on November 29, 1994. Presentation was give by our distinguished guest speaker Mr Stephen PRENSKY who is a research geologist with the U.S. Geological Survey in Colorado.

His discussion was titled "A Survey Of Recent Developments And Emerging Technology In Well Logging And Rock Characterization" and covered a necessity for ever more cost-effective technology, combined with the necessity to evaluate non-conventional reservoirs by means of both vertical and horizontal wells, serve as both the controlling factor and driving force, respectively, behind the development of new logging technology in both wireline, LWD and MWD.

The discussion was covered from downhole micro-processor technology with uphole high speed digital telemetry technology to new multiple sources and receivers array tool design and new high-angle, horizontal wells with slim hole technics.

Due to the time constrain, the subject was discussed rather shallow but wide range of area. Mr. Prensky has mentioned that all subject he discussed over this presentation is available on PC or Mac diskette from SPWLA publications.
