General Summary of the Symposium

The Third well logging symposium of Japan was successfully held in JNOC-TRC on September 24-25, 1997. Our sincere thanks to all the participant and sponsors for their contributions. From the third symposium, JNOC-TRC join us as co-sponsor of the event.

Following is a brief summary of the symposium.

(Participants)

The number of participants was 136 and 41% of them were from oil companies, 38% from service companies, 12% from universities & national research institutes and 9% from geothermal, geo-engineering and other industries. The participants from overseas were 18 and foreigners were 28.

(Opening Session)

Following the opening remarks by our president, Mr.Satoshi Tono and president of JNOC-TRC, Mr. Kuniaki Suzuki, Mr. Toshinobu Itoh from JAPEX Geothermal Kyushyu delivered a keynote address titled "Geothermal Exploration and Well Logging Technology in Japan". Mr. Masato Yasuda from JNOC-TRC presented "R&D Management in JNOC-TRC".

(Technical Sessions)

Twenty-five papers and two invited speaker were presented in 6 technical sessions. The session titles and the number of papers were as shown as follows;

- (1) Electrical/Electromagnetic Logging: 5
- (2) Fractured Reservoir: 5
- (3) General Formation Evaluation: 4
- (4) Petrophysical Properties/ Computer Applications: 5
- (5) Cased-hole/Production Logging: 3
- (6) Acoustic/Borehole Geophysics: 5

We had two invited speakers. The first, Mr. Johhny Brown introduced the Petrotechnical Open Software Corporation (POSC) in Session 3. The other invited speaker, Mr. Darwin Ellis from Schlumberger Doll Research presented the paper titled "Forward Modeling: An Aid for Interpreting Neutron Logs in Horizontal Wells" in Session 5.
