Personal Profiles for new Board Members

Kazuhiko Tezuka, candidate for Vice President, Technology, is a research manager of the reservoir measurements & characterization group in JAPEX Research Center. He joined JAPEX after he graduated from Tohoku University in 1984 with a B.E. degree in geophysical engineering. In 1993-1994, he worked as a visiting scientist at Earth Resources Laboratory in M.I.T. In 1997, he received Dr. of Engineering from Tohoku University in earth resources engineering.
